

AUBMC celebrates the "UN International Volunteer Day" to honor its volunteers and recognize their work

Beirut, Lebanon, December 5, 2017: To mark the United Nations International Volunteer Day (IVD) and under the auspices of the United Nations Special Coordinator for Lebanon (UNSCOL) Officer in Charge, Mr. Philippe Lazzarini, the American University of Beirut Medical Center (AUBMC) held a celebration ceremony to honor the contributions of its volunteer-involving funds and community members.

The event, which was held at Issam Fares Lecture Hall, highlighted the impact of volunteering on the development and progress of any community. Dr. Mona Osman, Family Medicine Doctor at the Department of Family Medicine, AUBMC applauded the key achievements and the outreach of community-oriented volunteering work that AUBMC and the Faculty of Medicine are offering.

"It is not the first time I witness the active and volunteer-based humanitarian work of the civil society in Lebanon conducted during the most difficult circumstances. 28 years ago, I started as a delegate in Lebanon for the International Committee for Red Cross, and I was impressed by the dedication, the courage, and the energy of the Red Cross volunteers. They have saved lives and alleviated the suffering of people caught in the civil war, they were the real heroes. This volunteering spirit has remained, and the United Nations mission in Lebanon is today proud to support initiatives promoting the volunteers' spirit," said Mr. Lazzarini.

Mandated by the United Nations General Assembly, the International Volunteer Day (IVD) - held annually on the 5th of December of each year- is viewed as a unique chance for volunteers and organizations to celebrate their efforts, share their values, and promote their work among their communities, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), United Nations agencies, government authorities and the private sector.
